What is Buddhism?

Founded by Siddhartha Gautama – Worship Buddha – follow eight fold path and four noble truths (India)-focuses on freeing yourself from material needs and desires.

What is Hinduism?

Based off the caste systembelieve in reincarnationpolytheistic-found in India-no founder

What is Confucianism?

Philosophy-Based off ideas of Confucius – morality, family order, government, social harmony - china

What is Shinto?

Main religion of Japan- ancestor worship-believe that everything has spirits(kami)-strong link to nature

What is Islam?

Founded by Muhammad –
monotheistic – Holy Book is the
Qur'an – believe in five pillars (fast –
prayer – hajj(trip to Mecca) – One
God(Allah) – helping others)

What is the Caste System?

Ranking of people in India by job, birth, wealth, etc.

What is Reincarnation?

To be reborn over and over againfound in Hinduism and Buddhism

What is Karma?

Good attitude and actions to help you stop reincarnating – way you act in this life determines who or what you are reincarnated into-found in Hinduism and Buddhism

What is Dharma?

Right way to act (Buddhism) – need to follow Dharma to be reincarnated to a better position or person

What is Nirvana?

Achieving Perfect Peace (in Buddhism)no more suffering or reincarnatingfreeing yourself from material desires

What are Non-Violent Protests?

To protest problems peacefully-allows sympathy for your cause

#### What is the Domino Theory?

Played a part in the cold war-Theory that if one country falls to communism than those around them will fall as well...led to other conflicts including the Korean War and the Vietnam War and Afghanistan in the 1980s.

Who is Mao Zedong?

First Communist leader of China-Head of CCP-led communist revolution in China...known as "Chairman Mao"

What is the Great Leap Forward?

Mao's idea to improve agriculture and industry in China-failed and ended in famine-the economy suffered

# Vocab Question #15 What is the Cultural Revolution of China?

The Goal was to renew China's spirit under communism and eliminate all social classes. Much of China's history was destroyed. Teachers and Artists were forced into hard labor or killed.

What happened at Tiananmen Square?

Political protest by students in 1989 who wanted a more Democratic China-led to the military opening fire on protestors

What is a Demilitarized Zone?

Empty buffer zone between two fighting countries. You can find this currently between North and South Korea at the 38<sup>th</sup> parallel

What impact does pollution have on the Yangtze River?

Makes it undrinkable and unusable

What impact does pollution have on the Ganges River?

Makes it undrinkable and unusable for farming

What river floods every year in China?

Huang He (yellow river)-China's sorrow

What is the Huang He nicknamed (why) {give both names}?

Yellow River (laos makes it yellow) – China's Sorrow (floods every year killing many)

What is the main transportation route in China?

Yangtze River (Chang Jiang)

Where is the Rainforest in Asia?

Indonesia-around the equator due to the tropical climate

Where do most people live in China and why?

North China Plain (very fertile land for farming and it has the Huang He River)

Where do most people live in India and why?

Ganges Plain (fertile land for farming and the Ganges River)

What is Mount Fuji?

Who led the nationalist movement in India against the British?

Gandhi and the Indian National Congress

Who led the nationalist movement in Vietnam?

Ho Chi Minh

Why was Mohandas Gandhi important to the world?

Led the first non-violent protest movement, encouraging others to use non-violence to achieve their goals-Martin Luther King, Jr. and Nelson Mandela modeled their protest movements after him.

How did the United States help Japan after WWII?

Helped them rebuild their infrastructure after we bombed them – helped them write a constitution and set up a democracy

Why did the Korean War occur and who was involved?

North Korea wanted to be communist and South Korea wanted to be democratic – first conflict of the Cold war – n: Russia and China – S: United States

### Why did the Vietnam War occur and who was involved?

North Vietnam wanted to be communist and South Vietnam wanted to be democratic – due to a civil war in the country – N: Ho Chi Min, Viet Cong, Russia and China – S: United States

What was the impact of the Vietnam War?

Proved that the United States could be defeated by a smaller, lesser power-Vietnam was united as one communist country

What is the government type of India, China, and Japan?

India: Federal Republic with a Parliamentary Democracy

**China: Communist** 

Japan: Constitutional monarchy with a parliament


What type of economy do China, India, Japan, and North Korea have?

China: mixed leaning more toward command


India: mixed with traditional in the rural villages

Japan: mixed (best economy)




